

CVLINK is a 40-mile transportation corridor and recreation pathway that provides a safe route to walk, run, bike, or use low-speed electric vehicles such as golf carts. The link is built largely along the Whitewater River from Highway 111 and the Chino Wash in North Palm Springs to Airport Boulevard in the City of Coachella. CV Link also includes a branch in South Palm Springs along Tahquitz Creek as well as on-street segments in Palm Springs and Palm Desert.

CV Link Features

- Dual pathways separate pedestrians from bicycles and low-speed electric vehicles (LSEVs)
- Connectivity to parks, shopping districts and schools
- Shade structures with solar panels
- Rest areas with benches, bike parking, and drinking fountains. Restrooms available at nearby parks along the route.
- Wayfinding and interpretive signs
- ADA compliant, providing safe access and use for persons with disabilities
- Creative lighting, including solar path lights
- Public art spaces
- Drought-resistant landscaping
- A route for walks, races and marathons

Rules & Safety Tips

- **SHARE THE PATH** – Bikes, E-bikes, LSEVs, and pedestrians.
- **STAY RIGHT, PASS LEFT** – Ring your bell or call out “on your left” when passing.
- **GO A SAFE SPEED** – 20 MPH max and slow down when others are present.
- **BE VISIBLE** – Use lights and reflectors, wear bright or reflective clothing at night.
- **CHECK YOUR BIKE** – Inspect brakes, tires, and chain before riding.
- **KEEP HYDRATED** – Always bring plenty of water for your ride.
- **PETS ON A LEASH** – Please keep under control, pickup waste, and bring a water bowl!
