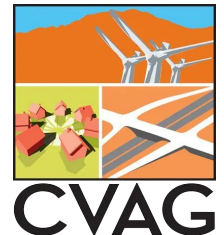
- Identifying walking and biking routes from neighborhoods to daily destinations such as schools, parks, community centers, and businesses
