

CV Link is a 40-mile shared use pathway for pedestrians, bicycles, and low-speed electric vehicles such as golf carts. The link is built largely along the Whitewater River from Highway 111 and the Chino Wash in North Palm Springs to Airport Boulevard in the City of Coachella. CV Link also includes a branch in South Palm Springs largely along Tahquitz Creek as well as on-street segments in South Palm Springs and Palm Desert. CV Link was substantially completed in June of 2025 and is managed by the Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG) in collaboration with cities and the Desert Recreation District.

CV Link facilitates a safer, more attractive, and economically thriving corridor to serve the needs of residents and visitors throughout the Coachella Valley. The Link connects users to employment centers, shopping, schools, friends and recreational opportunities. This exciting alternative transportation corridor enables healthier lifestyles, spurs economic innovation, and makes the Coachella Valley a more sustainable and appealing place to live, work and play!

- Dual pathways separate pedestrians from bicycles and low-speed electric vehicles
- Access Points with rest areas that include bike racks, benches, water fountains, and shade structures with solar powered USB charging
- Wayfinding and interpretive signs
- ADA compliant providing safe access and use for the disabled and handicapped
- Creative lighting including solar powered LED pathway lights
- Public art and spectacular views
- Future event space for walks, races and marathons
